PIXEL - POINTILLISM POSTER DESIGN

Point is the first and simplest element of visual design. Point serves as the focus of something visual, and therefore draws attention. Even if there is only one point, or one mark, on a blank page our brains will make it mean something.






ILLUSTRATION POSTER DESIGN

Draw shapes and paths using the Pen tool · About color · Select colors · Use and create swatches · Adjust colors








PATTERN POSTER DESIGN






PROJECT: TWIST ENERGY DRINK – SOCIAL MEDIA ADVERTISING CONCEPT








SOCIAL AWARENESS CAMPAIGN – FIGHT AGAINST ILLITERACY


what do you know about hammerhead shark ?

Hammerhead sharks are a group of sharks belonging to the family *Sphyrnidae, named for their distinctive, flattened, hammer-shaped head, called a **cephalofoil. There are **nine species* of hammerhead sharks, with the *great hammerhead (Sphyrna mokarran)* being the largest.

- Wide, flat, hammer-like head










PROJECT: BOOK COVER DE-SIGN – INSPIRED BY LOST IN SPACE
